The following instructions are for purchases in North, South and Central America only.

It's as easy as 1- 2- 3

1. Install version 5.9 IE-33 software on your iPAQ.

Remove your iPAQ from the IE-33 jacket and perform a soft reset*. Insert the iPAQ (sans jacket) into the ActiveSync cradle and establish a partnership between your PC and the iPAQ. Visit Ivie's web site at <http://www.ivie.com/software.htm> and download version 5.9 of the IE-33 software. Navigate on your PC to the folder where your new version 5.9 resides and double click on the file: IE33-Setup-v5.9.exe. If, during the install process, you are asked if you want to overwrite some files, say "Yes to All". When you're done with the install, slide the iPAQ back into the IE-33 jacket.

2. Use IvieEnable to discover your iPAQ serial number.

When you install version 5.9, a very small separate software program will also be installed on your iPAQ titled "IvieEnable". Open the IvieEnable application showing in your iPAQ Start Menu (IvieEnable will appear in your Start menu if there is room in the start menu for another entry.) If your Start menu is full, you can use the iPAQ File Explorer to navigate to Program Files > IE33 and double-tap on IvieEnable.exe. Opening IvieEnable will reveal a "code" which is actually your iPAQ's serial number. Write down or otherwise record your iPAQ serial number. *Note: The serial number is case sensitive.*

3. Send the serial number and other necessary info to us at Ivie.

Fill out the **RT-60 Order Form.PDF** with your contact information, payment information, etc., and be sure to include your iPAQ serial number in the appropriate field. You can email the form to us, fax it to us, or call us on the phone (801-766-7600) with the information. As soon as the financial transaction is completed we will email you with the Activation Code for your particular iPAQ (based on the serial number). Use IvieEnable to enter the Activation Code. That's it! The new RT-60 software choice will now appear under the IE-33's Function menu, and you're ready to go.

Note: To take full advantage of your new software, we highly recommend that you visit Ivie's web site to download the Setup CAB file and CAB Security File Instructions <http://www.ivie.com/software.htm> Using the CAB file you can restore your IE-33 program at any time in the field. Following the instructions in the CAB Security File Instructions will assure that your data and configuration information are always secure.

You will find the RT-60 Quick Start instructions at the same web location. The IE-33 User's Manual RT-60 addendum will soon be on the web page in the same place.

* Prior to inserting the iPAQ/IE-33 in the ActiveSync cradle (or attaching the sync cable to the iPAQ) you should a) **separate the iPAQ from the IE-33 jacket** and b) **perform a "soft reset" of the iPAQ** by inserting the stylus into the small hole in the bottom of the iPAQ for a second or so. You can tell you have performed the rest by observing the iPAQ screen.
